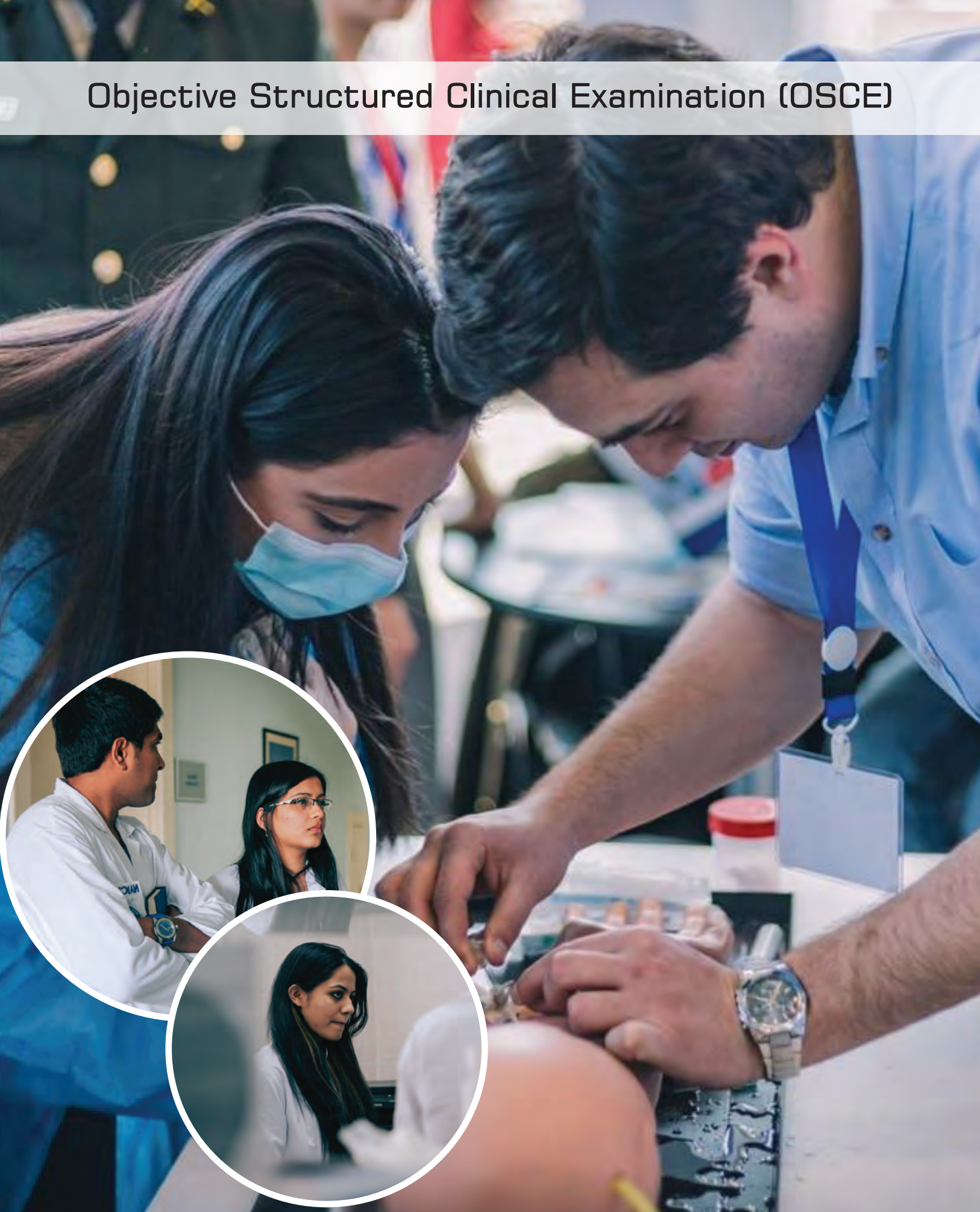

Participation of students of the Faculty of Medicine in exchange programs

Five MD students, Sabaru Venkata Naga Meghara, Rahul Kumar ghanate, Shweta Tilante, Shivangi Singh and Syed Yaseen Ahmed from European University Faculty of Medicine attended a clinical course at Ege University hospital from 15 to 19 April 2019. The students learnt through observing of interns who compiled medical histories and physically examined patients. Afterwards the interns and students discussed the real-life cases with possible diagnosis.

The Faculty of Medicine financed students accommodation, insurance and visa costs. The Office of International Relations ensured the students to get visas and book accommodation as well as provided consultations concerning the visit.



The final results of the 2nd International Diagnostic Championship



213 teams from 104 medical schools of 49 countries entered the competition of the World Final of the Championship. Format of the competition was to discuss the cases provided for them by inSimu Patient app and diagnose all the patients in a very short time.

The final score was calculated based on several factors: correctness of the diagnosis, diagnostic pathway, time and cost-efficiency. Ordering the most relevant tests was key to get a high Score.

Team of European University made by 3 students of EU Medical Faculty: Venkata Naga Sarabu Meghana, Shweta Tilante, Mohammed Kumar Naick successfully participated in the final competition and were awarded with 3rd place. EU team members received Amazon Gift cards and inSimu Premium subscription from the championship organizers.

Competition for Medical Doctor Students to participate in the IFMSA (International Federation of Medical Students Association) exchange project was held at the Faculty of Medicine of the European University.

Within the project, students will take one month (28 days) of clinical practice during 2021-22 years in one of the participating Countries (Italy, Moldova, Serbia, Hungary, Romania, Peru).

Six Medical Doctor Students were selected as a result of the competition: Alikya Chipurupalli – Italy, Sahishnuta Suryakant Deshmukh – Hungary, Reet Agarwal - Romania, Uppal Ravisha – Peru, Joji jincy Mariya – Serbia, Rishu – Moldova. According to the project, the students sent from the European University will be hosted by six countries, and students from these countries will arrive in Georgia.

Within the project, European University undertakes to plan clinical practice for 6 students from host countries. The University will reimburse the clinical practice and the living expenses of the international students arriving under the project, as a result, European University students will be exempt from clinical practice fee and living expenses in the host countries.

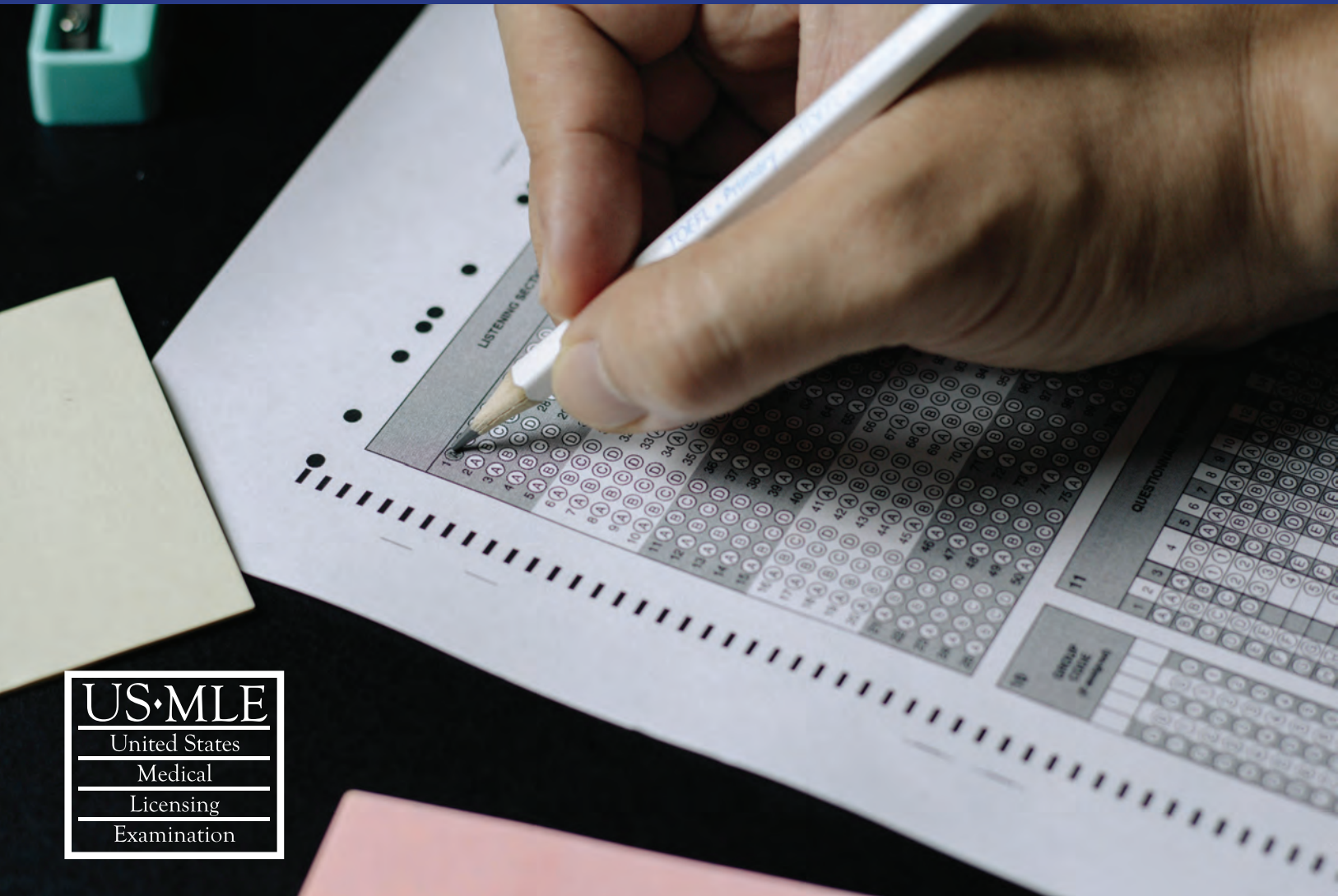

The University Dormitory

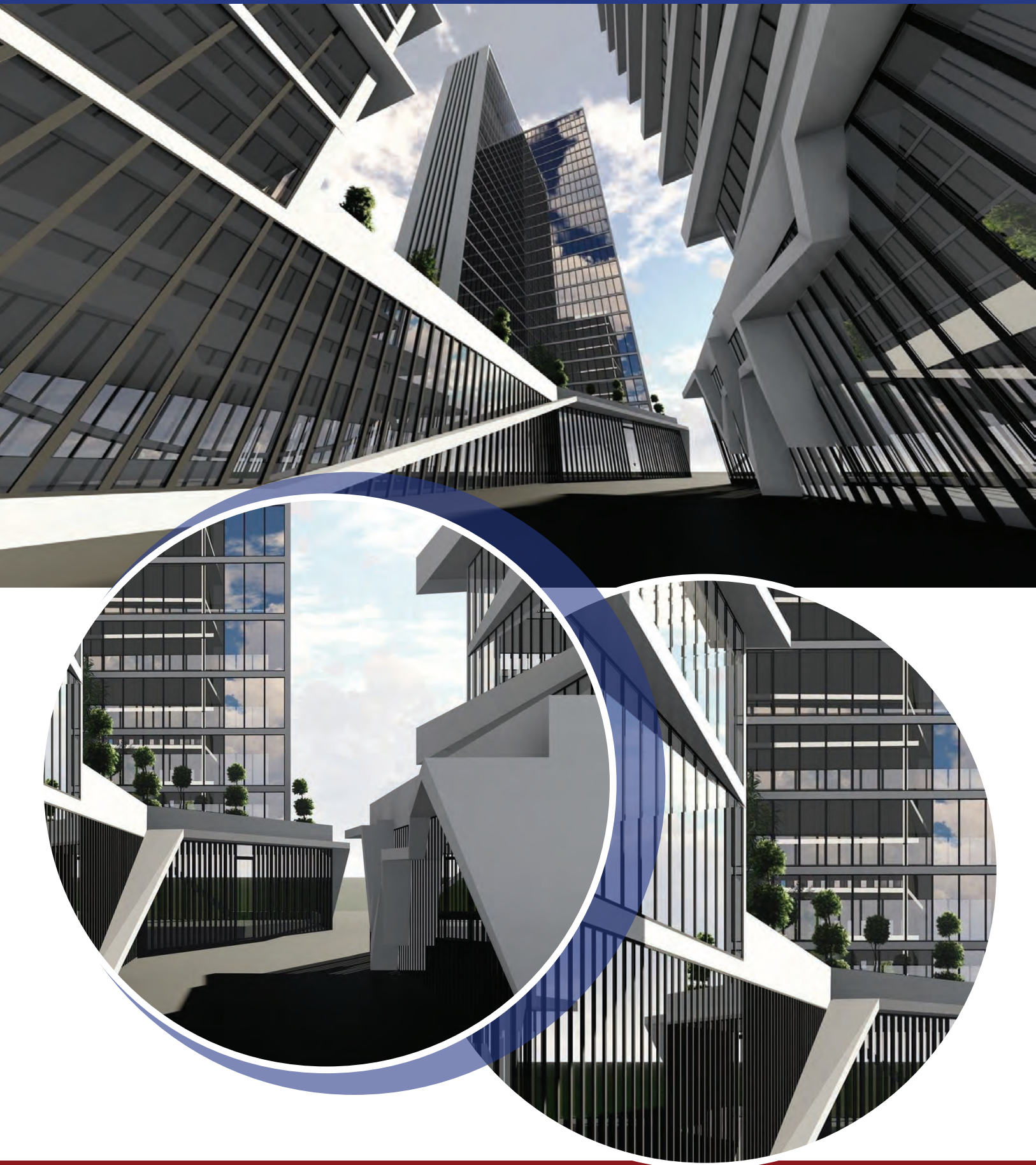
